Scholarship Program Guidelines

OBJECTIVE

To encourage and promote educational enhancement in science and technical fields for the T.C.R.G. families by assisting with escalating costs in making available a scholarship program.

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS:

Award - \$500

Awards may be used for any direct educational related purposes.

Acceptance Criteria

Nomination to become a scholarship candidate is unlimited.

Candidates shall be nominated by a T.C.R.G. member in good standing.

Preferred course of study Science or Technical, that benefit the member companies.

Applications submitted between February 6 & March 27, 2009.

Post-secondary and undergraduate programs will be reviewed with highest priority.

Selection Process:

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship review Board. The review board will be made up of the Education Committee Chair Person, the current T.C.R.G. President, the T.C.R.G. past President, and up to two additional volunteers. Each review board member will have one vote, and the scholarship recipient will be decided by simple majority vote.

It is not required to present the scholarship every year.

In the event of a tie, the Education Committee reserves the right to decide how to make the award, i.e., split the single scholarship into two \$250 scholarships, award two \$500 scholarships etc.
